Scholarship Policy

The Coalición Latinos Unidos de Lake County award scholarship to Lake County students of Hispanic/Latino descent who are pursuing their education in an accredited college or university.

All scholarship recipients will be invited and expected to attend the Noche the Gala event following the award to be recognized or arrange for a representative to attend in their place. If a Noche de Gala is not planned for that year, students will be required to attend an awards ceremony, or arrange a representative to attend in their place.

The full scholarship amount shall be paid directly to the bursar/financial aid office of the school the student is attending and will be applied towards tuition and fees.

Starting in 2020, this scholarship will be a renewable scholarship, meaning recipients from previous years would be able to reapply for this scholarship. Scholarship requirement for those might be different than those who are first applicants.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

To be consider for a CLULC scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a high school senior, under grad or graduate student
- Be a resident of Lake County
- Latino or of Latino descent
- Have and maintain a cumulative un-weighted GPA of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have participated in community/volunteer activities
- Justify financial needs
- Attend, or be accepted into an accredited college of university
- Complete in its entirety and submit the application from with all the required documents
- All qualifying students are encouraged to apply



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How To apply

To apply, please do as follows:

1. Fill out application completely. Obtain a form from the CLCLC Board or go to its web site www.clulc.org to download one.
2. Send official school transcripts (high school if the applicant is in high school and college if already attending on).
3. Proof of admissions admission to the school of your choice.
4. Submit ONLY two letters of recommendation provided by people not related to the applicant, in letterhead and with original signature. Letters not exceed 1 page
5. Submit 500 to 750-word essay, typed and double space, describing yourself and how the scholarship will help you achieve your goals and how you may be able to use your education in the service of the Latino community of Lake County.
6. Mail the complete education postmarked no later than the date specified in the announcement (Do not send application or any documentation by email!):

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How the Scholarship is Awarded

- A selection committee, made up of CLULC Board members, will review the scholarship applications
- The committee will apply the included rubric to qualify the applicants
- The highest scoring students will be awarded scholarships
- Incomplete applications will not be given consideration
- The winners will be officially notified by the CLULC President
- The Scholarship money will be sent directly to the school of the student's choice
- Winner(s) will be required to submit a photograph and short bio for posting in the CLULC's website, scholarship page
- Students who don't qualify for the scholarship will be given a list of other potential scholarships
- Incomplete applications packets will not be considered, and the applicant will not be notified about missing documents
